On March 20th, the Colourstrings Orchestra gave an excellent performance at the Richmond Festival on Saturday and were awarded the Duncan Beat Trophy. In addition to this, they have been invited to perform at the Festival Showcase in Richmond on May 7th. This is a real honour and vote of confidence for the orchestra.

The Showcase will be held in the Queen Charlotte Hall, Richmond Adult & Community College, Parkshot, Richmond on May 7th and will begin at 7.00pm. It will be followed by the presentation of major awards by the Mayor of Richmond and the event should end by about 9.30pm. The general public is admitted to the concert and the cost is £4.50 for adults and £2.50 for children & concessions. Tickets are available at the door.

The Colourstrings Orchestra have also been invited to perform in the Young Talent of Kew concert in the Barn church, Kew on June 22nd as part of the Kew music festival (www.kewmusicfestival.com)

Outside of the school, our pupils have been enjoying musical success. Congratulations are due to Jason Arnold (guitar pupil of Michele Salvemini), who has been awarded a music scholarship to Emanuel School in Wandsworth for September this year. Isobel Mason (violin pupil of Cressida Wislocki) sang with her school choir, the St. Paul's Singers, in the Leith Hill Musical Festival Open Competition for Youth Choirs on Saturday, March 28th. They were awarded first prize with distinction and



received the competition trophy.
